



# Cookies Statement

Our website uses cookies and other related technologies (for convenience all technologies are referred to as "cookies"). Cookies are also placed by third parties we have engaged. In the document below we inform you about the use of cookies on our websites.

## What are Cookies?

Cookies are small data files that are placed on your computer or mobile device when you visit a website, mobile app or use an online platform. Cookies are widely used by online service providers to facilitate and help to make the interaction between users and websites faster and easier, as well as to provide reporting information.

Cookies set by the website owner (in this case, ISPCC) are called "first party cookies". Cookies set by parties other than the website owner are called "third party cookies". Third party cookies enable third party features or functionality to be provided on or through the website (e.g. videos, social media, interactive content and analytics). The parties that set these third party cookies can recognise your computer or device both when it visits the website in question and also when it visits certain other websites.

## Why do we use Cookies?

We use first party and third party cookies for several reasons. Some cookies are required for technical reasons in order for our Website to operate, and we refer to these as "essential" or "strictly necessary" cookies. Third parties serve cookies through our Websites for analytics and other purposes. This is described in more detail below.

## Technologies we use

A log file (or script) is a piece of program code that is used to make our websites function properly and interactively. This code is executed on our server or on your device. A web beacon (or a pixel tag) is a small, invisible piece of text or image on a website that is used to monitor traffic on a website.

In order to do this, various data about you is stored using web beacons. Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site.

## Essential Website Cookies:

The cookies which is served by the ISPCC and Cookiebot, are strictly necessary to provide you with services available through our website and to use some of its features, such as donating to ISPCC or Lodging your Funds after an event.

Because these cookies are strictly necessary to deliver the website to you, you cannot refuse them. You can block or delete them by changing your browser settings (as described bellow under the heading "How can I control cookies?") however you might not be able to use the website to its full extent anymore.

The cookies served by ISPCC help the website remember your default language and your session information to remember what you type into forms so that you don't have to re-enter the data if you move away from the page and then come back. Theses cookies disappear when you close the browser client.

## How You Can Control Cookies:

You have the right to decide whether to accept or reject cookies. You can exercise your cookie preferences by clicking on the links provided above.

You can set or amend your web browser controls to accept or refuse cookies. If you choose to reject cookies, you may still use our website though your access to some functionality and areas may be restricted. As the means by which you can refuse cookies through your web browser controls vary from browser-to-browser, you should visit your browser's help menu for more information or click on the relevant link bellow:
